Show Rules

General Rules

1. All steer exhibitors must be ages 9-19 as of January 1, 2008.
Breeding cattle exhibitors must be 21 and under as of January 1, 2008
or meet the age requirements of their respective breed associations.
2. Entry fees for Show A:
 - Steers and Heifers - \$40 per head
 - Showmanship A - \$10 per entry
3. Entry fees for Show B:
 - Steers and Heifers - \$40 per head
 - Showmanship B - \$10 per entry

****ONLY animals entered in Show A can be entered in Show B. Animals must be entered in Show B to be eligible for Show B Showmanship.**

4. Entries must be postmarked by Friday, September 19, 2008. Late entries will be accepted prior to the show, provided space permits. Late entries will be charged an additional fee.
5. There will be NO REFUNDS on entries paid to Chico State's Northern Exposure.
6. Management reserves the right to change anything that will better accommodate and/or improve the show.
7. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal. Any exception must be approved prior to the show by the show management. If, and only if, a showman is currently showing one animal and has another animal to show simultaneously, an alternate showman is acceptable.
8. Bedding (straw or shavings) can be provided by the exhibitor or it will be available at the show for purchase. Please use designated dumping areas only!!
9. Exhibitors are responsible for removing their own bedding to the designated dumping areas. Failure to remove bedding will result in a \$20 fine per head and/or withholding of premiums.

10. ALL EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO OBTAIN AN OFFICIAL RELEASE FORM provided by Northern Exposure Staff - A release form will only be given after a stall/area inspection.
11. Absolutely NO consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed. Chico State policy prohibits the consumption of alcohol at student functions.
12. Ethical treatment of all animals and ethical conduct from the exhibitor is expected at Northern Exposure.
13. Any animal exhibiting signs of infectious or any unsightly conditions will not be permitted to show at the Northern Exposure Junior Cattle Show as determined by a veterinarian.
14. Any animal that is deemed a safety hazard by show management will be disqualified with no refund.
15. Please bring generators – power may be limited.
16. No dogs will be allowed at or around the show ring.

Heifer Show

1. All heifers must be registered in the name of the exhibitor. Registration papers are to be checked-in by Friday, October 17, 2008 by 8:00pm.
2. All breeding cattle exhibitors are required to send a copy of the official registration papers with entry forms and the ORIGINAL REGISTRATION PAPERS ARE REQUIRED AT “SHOW CHECK-IN.”
3. Only animals shown in SHOW A can be entered in SHOW B. Animals must be entered in SHOW B to be eligible for SHOW B SHOWMANHIP!
4. Any animal that is deemed a safety hazard by show management will be disqualified with no refund.
5. The heifer show will have 7 breed divisions. Heifer divisions are as follows: Hereford (Polled & Horned combined), Angus, Shorthorn, Maine-Anjou (Including Mainetainers), Limousin, Charolais and All Other Breeds. We will also be offering a commercial (non-registered) heifer division that **will not** be included for CJLA points.
6. If a breed show does not have at least 5 entries, management reserves the right to move these animals into the AOB classes. Management also reserves the right to make any changes to the show that will benefit the outcome.

Steer Show

1. Official steer weigh-in will take place Saturday October 18, 2008 from 5:00-7:00 PM.
2. Only animals shown in SHOW A can be entered in SHOW B. Animals must be entered in SHOW B to be eligible for SHOW B SHOWMANHIP!
3. Any animal that is deemed a safety hazard by show management will be disqualified with no refund.

4. The steer show will have three weight divisions: Prospect, Progress, and Market. Northern Exposure management will break and post the classes on the day of the show. At this time a division break of light/heavy may occur.
5. There will be three breed divisions: British (Angus, Hereford, and Shorthorn steers will show together) AOC, Black/Black X. Official breeds will be called at the scale. Management's decision is FINAL!
6. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal. Any exception must be approved prior to the show by the show management. If, and only if, a showman is currently showing one animal and has another animal to show simultaneously, an alternate showman is acceptable.

Cattle Showmanship

1. Cattle Showmanship (age as of January 1, 2008): Junior Division (9-12) Intermediate Division (13-15) and Senior Division (16-19).
2. Heifer Showmanship Senior Division ages are 16 to 21.
3. Payout for showmanship will be divided among the top placing individuals in each division.
4. All exhibitors must show their own animal. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
5. Cattle showmanship will combine steers and heifers.
6. Animals must be entered in SHOW B to be eligible for SHOW B showmanship.
7. FITTING IS OPTIONAL FOR SHOWMANSHIP!!
