

SHOW RULES

Northern Exposure “Fall Classic”

November 3-5, 2017 Rolling Hills Equestrian Center – Corning, CA

General Information/Rules:

1. All steer exhibitors must be 19 and under as of January 1, 2017 and Breeding Cattle exhibitors must be 21 and under as of January 1, 2017. These ages apply to those planning on gaining CJLA points from the Northern Exposure Show. The management reserves the right to adjust these ages if the need arises and we will adhere to specific breed rules (for heifer exhibitors) as well.
2. Entry fees for Show A:
 - Steers and Heifers - \$40 per head
 - Showmanship - \$10 per entry
3. Entry fees for Show B:
 - Steers and Heifers - \$40 per head
 - Showmanship - \$10 per entry

4. Entries must be postmarked by October 18, 2017. Late entries will be accepted prior to the show, provided space permits. Late entries will be charged an additional fee. All late entries are REQUIRED to purchase horse stalls for stalling.
5. **There will be NO REFUNDS on entries paid to the Northern Exposure !!!!**
6. Management reserves the right to change **anything** that will better accommodate and/or improve the show.
7. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal. Any exception must be approved prior to the show by the show management. If, and only if, a showman is currently showing one animal and has another animal show simultaneously, an alternate showman is acceptable.
8. Bedding can be provided by the exhibitor or it will be available for purchase. Please use designated dumping areas only!! Exhibitors are responsible for removing all feed, hay and garbage – but bedding will be removed by the facility staff. Failure to remove these articles will result in a @ \$20 fine per head and/or withholding of premiums.
9. Ethical treatment of all animals and ethical conduct from the exhibitor is expected at Northern Exposure.
10. Any animal exhibiting signs of infectious or unsightly conditions will not be permitted to show at the Northern Exposure Junior Cattle Show as determined by a veterinarian.
11. Any animal that is deemed a safety hazard by show management will be disqualified with no refund.
12. PLEASE bring generators – power will be limited.
13. No dogs will be allowed at or around the show ring.
14. ALL CJLA RULES APPLY!!
15. OUT OF STATE EXHIBITORS **MUST** have appropriate health inspections and brand inspections!
16. Payouts will depend on the success of the show. All expenses must be paid prior to payouts being decided or disbursed. The Northern Exposure Events are self sustaining and run independently on entry fees and sponsorships alone. There are no outside funds supporting these events!! Thank you for your consideration.

SHOW RULES

Heifer Show

1. All heifers must be registered in the name of the exhibitors – and the original papers must be presented at check-in. Check-in will take place Friday evening.
2. All breeding cattle exhibitors are required to send a copy of the official registration papers with entry forms and the ORIGINAL REGISTRATION PAPERS ARE REQUIRED AT “SHOW CHECK-IN”.
3. The heifer show will have the following breed divisions: Hereford (polled and horned combined), Angus, Shorthorn, Maine-Anjou (including Maintainers), Charolais, All Other Purebred and Percentage. We will also be offering a commercial/grade (non-registered) heifer division that **WILL NOT** be included for CJLA points or Supreme Female judging.
4. New 2017 CJLA rule: **BREEDING HEIFER ENTRIES CANNOT BE ENTERED IN MORE THAN ONE CJLA BREED DIVISION AT ANY SHOW.** CJLA realizes it is possible for some Percentage Heifers to be registered with more than one Association based on the guidelines of those Associations. **However, points cannot be earned in more than one division at any CJLA sanctioned heifer show with the same animal.** Registered Heifers cannot also enter a Market Heifer Division. (This is not a sanctioned division but some shows do offer a Mkt Heifer Division in conjunction with their CJLA Show). A Mkt Heifer cannot enter a CJLA Registered Heifer Division at the same show.

Steer Show

1. Official Steer weigh-in will take place **Saturday evening** following the completion of the heifer show. There will be **NO** weigh-in on Sunday morning (unless prior arrangements are made)!!
2. The steer show will have two weight divisions: Prospect and Progress. Northern Exposure management will break and post classes on the day of the show. At this time, a division break of light/heavy may occur. A market division will only be offered if the numbers permit.
3. There will be three breed divisions: British (Angus, Hereford and Shorthorn steers will show together), AOC (all other color) and Black/Black X. Official breeds will be called at the scale. Management’s decision is FINAL!!!
4. All BRITISH STEERS (Angus, Hereford and Shorthorn) WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE REGISTRATION PAPERS VERIFYING PARENTAGE AND PEDIGREE in order to be shown in the British Steer Division. These registration papers must be official purebred steer registration papers from the respective national breed association. The registration papers must be in the name of the exhibitor.

Showmanship

1. Cattle Showmanship (age as of January 1, 2017): Pee Wee (8 & under) Junior Division (9-12) Intermediate Division (13-15) and Senior Division (16-21). Steer and Heifer showmanship are combined. Show A showmanship on Saturday and Show B showmanship on Sunday.
2. All exhibitors must show their own animal. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
3. FITTING IS OPTIONAL FOR SHOWMANSHIP!!
4. You must have an animal entered in Show A/Show B to participate in Show A/Show B Showmanship (including the animal you choose to use in showmanship).

Market Heifer Division

1. This division WILL NOT receive CJLA points. If an exhibitor chooses to use a market heifer in showmanship, they will not receive CJLA Showmanship points!
2. New 2017 CJLA rule in regards to the market heifer division: Registered Heifers cannot also enter a Market Heifer Division. (This is not a sanctioned division but some shows do offer a Mkt Heifer Division in conjunction with their CJLA Show). A Mkt Heifer cannot enter a CJLA Registered Heifer Division at the same show.
3. The Market Heifer Show will NOT be broken by breed, ONLY by weight. There WILL NOT be a prospect, progress, market division champions. ONLY an overall champion market heifer will be selected.
4. The overall Champion Market Heifer will compete in the Supreme “Steer” Selection.
5. Northern Exposure management will break and post the classes on the day of the show following official weigh-in.
6. Weight discrepancies must be decided before the animal leaves the scale.
